

Birds from Transcarpathia, Ukraine, in the collections of the National Museum of the Czech Republic

The National Museum of the Czech Republic, possesses 155 specimens (skins and mounts) of 63 species of birds from Transcarpathia, mostly collected during 1930–1938 when that region was a part of the then Czechoslovakia. Full list of these specimens is given here. The most important collections were made by Julius Komárek (1892–1955) in 1930–1933, Otakar Štěpánek (1903–1995) in 1937, and V. Danihelka (*fl.* 1934–1938) in 1934–1938. This paper fills a gap in the history of ornithological research in Zakarpattia and provides valuable historical data on the distribution of birds in that region. However, no species listed here are new to or rarities in the region.

Národní muzeum v Praze, Česko, vlastní 155 exemplářů (balek a dermoplastů) 63 druhů ptáků ze Zakarpatska. Většina byla ulovena v letech 1930–1938, kdy bylo ono území částí tehdejšího Československa. V této práci uvádím plný soupis těchto exemplářů. Nejdůležitější sbírky pocházejí od Julia Komárka (1892–1955) z let 1930–1933, Otakara Štěpánka (1903–1995) z roku 1937 a V. Danihelky (*fl.* 1934–1938) z let 1934–1938. Tato práce zaplňuje málo známou mezery v historii ornitologického výzkumu Zakarpattia a přináší cenné historické údaje o výskytu ptáků v dané oblasti. Žádný ze zaznamenaných druhů však není pro danou oblast nový, ani nepatří mezi vzácné zatoulance.

INTRODUCTION

The territory of Zakarpattia was nearly unexplored in terms of ornithology until the early 20th century. Its avifauna was first compiled by Aleksander Grabar (1883–1959; Grabar 1931, 1932, Lugovoj 1997), and later by Fedor Iogannovič Strautman (1912–1967; Strautman 1963a, 1963b).

From 1919 to 1939 (and then for a few weeks in 1945), Transcarpathia (then called Subcarpathian Ruthenia) was an autonomous part of Czechoslovakia. During that period, the natural history of Transcarpathia was studied by various Czech naturalists (Mišanin 2022). However, their work did not result in any significant ornithological publication. Despite that, some specimens were collected in 1930–1938, of which 155 belonging to 63 species are currently deposited in the National Museum of the Czech Republic.

Significant collections were made by three persons: Julius Komárek (1892–1955), a zoologist at the Charles University and the Research Institute of Forestry, repeatedly collected in Zakarpattia during 1930–1933, mainly at Velikij Byčkiv; Otakar Štěpánek (1903–1995), a zoologist at the National Museum of the Czech Republic, collected in June–July 1937 in Apšinec' Forest; and V. Danihelka (*fl.* 1934–1938), a Czech teacher based at Veliki Kom'ati collected birds in that region in 1934–1938 (for details see below).

MATERIAL AND METHODS

I reidentified and cataloged the specimens during my tenure as the research curator of birds at the National Museum in Prague from 2003 to 2018. The sequence of taxa and English and scientific nomenclature follow IOC (Gill et al. 2024). Cyrillic characters were transliterated into Latin characters using the ISO 9:1995 standard (ISO 1995). Zoological collections of the National Museum of the Czech Republic (NMP) are prefixed with "P6V".

Collectors

The following 12 persons were given in catalogues and on labels as collectors of specimens listed in this paper. Most probably, they collected the specimens personally in the field, but some might have obtained the specimens from other persons (*cf.* Lucas & Lucas 2014). The list of collectors is arranged alphabetically.

Danihelka V. (*fl.* 1934–1938), teacher at Veliki Kom'ati, 41 specimens from 1934–1938.

Jirsík Josef (1898–1956), Czech ornithologist, 1 specimen from 1935.

Komárek Julius (1892–1955), Czech zoologist, 11 specimens during 1930–1933
(Komárek 1942, Lugovoj 2004).

Kotek František (1912–1994), Czech taxidermist, 8 specimens during 1936–1938.

Peprný Ladislav J. (*fl.* 1935–1945), Czech soldier and taxidermist, 2 specimens
during 1935–1936.

Plachetka Karel (1877–1961), Czech soldier and ornithologist (Káda 1971, Hušek
2021), 1 specimen from 1931.

Pokorný A. (*fl.* 1934), 3 specimens from December 1934.

Rambousek (*fl.* 1931–1933), forester at Velikij Byčkiv, 2 specimens from 1931–1933.

Špaček J. (*fl.* 1936–1938), forester at Buštino, 6 specimens from 1936–1938.

Štěpánek Otakar (1903–1995), Czech zoologist, 73 specimens from June–July 1937.

Zeman P. (*fl.* 1933), engineer, lived in Praha-Bubeneč, 1 specimen from 1933.

Ukrainian names were transliterated into Latin characters using the ISO 9:1995 standard (ISO 1995). Alternative spellings and names are given in parentheses, where also details on localities are provided (taken from original labels).




Fig. 1. – Localities mentioned in the text. 1 – Apšinec', 2 – Bogdan, 3 – Buštino, 4 – Dilove, 5 – Il'nicá, 6 – Kobilec'ka Polána, 7 – Nevic'ke, 8 – Nimec'ka Mokra, 9 – Poroškovo, 10 – Skotars'ke, 11 – Svidovec', 12 – Užgorod, 13 – Velikì Kom'âti, 14 – Velikij Byčkiv, 15 – Volovec'.
